Aside from non-melanoma skin cancer, breast cancer is the most common form of cancer in women.

- 192,370 new cases of breast cancer will be diagnosed in women. The chance of developing breast cancer in a woman's life is less than 1 in 8 (12%)
- 40,820 women died from breast cancer.
- There are currently 2.5 million breast cancer survivors in the US.
- Breast cancer is about 100 times less common among men than among women but still a factor. For men, the lifetime risk of getting breast cancer is about 1 in 1,000.
